What is PAC?

PAC is a project led by young people, for young people.
It is a movement of young people across the country using their voices to create change.
In Leicester, we want to focus on policing and make things better for young people.

Who can become a PAC lead?

- Young people aged 16-20
- From East or West Leicester who have been involved with the police and are impacted by violence.
- No previous experience necessary just a passion for creating change in your community!





















What will I be doing as a PAC lead?

PAC leads will:

- Design questions to ask young people around policing
- Talk and listen to young people
- Create projects using what young people share
- Support other young people to get involved

What's in it for me?

- Up to £390 per month
- Flexibility up to 32 hours a month around your current commitments
- Being part of a network of young people
- Engaging training
- Career pathway support
- New friends
- Creating lasting change
